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THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF IMU

The tenth General Assembly of IMU will be held on July 31 to August 2, 1986, at Oakland Airport Hilton, California, USA.

According to the Statutes of the Union, each National Adhering Organization "shall appoint and certify to the Secretary of the Union a delegation which shall have the number of votes corresponding to the Group in which it adheres, as follows:

Group:	I	II	III	IV	V
Number of votes:	1	2	3	4	5

provided that the number of delegates shall not exceed the corresponding number of votes. Any National Adhering Organization which desires to ensure its full quota of representatives at meetings of the General Assembly by the appointment of alternates for its regularly named delegates may do so, provided that no such alternate shall be permitted to participate in the work of the General Assembly until he has been duly certified to the Secretary of the Union as assuming the powers and duties of the delegate he has been designated to replace. No person shall be a member of the delegation of more than one country. Voting by the General Assembly shall be by delegations, provided that each delegation shall be free to cast the votes to which it is entitled either as a unit or divided in such a manner as it may determine".

The National Adhering Organizations have been requested to designate their delegations with the form on the following page.

As provided for in the By-Laws of the Union, National Adhering Organizations may propose business to be transacted at the General Assembly. Such proposals shall reach the Secretary at least four months before the meeting, i.e., not later than March 31, preferably before March 1, 1986.

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Change of Group

In a ballot conducted among the National Adhering Organizations of IMU, the status of Canada was raised from III to IV; the change is effective from January 1, 1986. All votes received, 67 out of 115 possible, were in favor of the change.

Special Development Fund

The Union has again appealed to the National Committees, several mathematical societies and other organizations for contributions to the Special Development Fund, the proceeds of which are mainly used as travel grants to the International Congresses of Mathematicians.

Our previous appeal brought in donations from the London Mathematical Society and Wiskundig Genootschap, to the value of USD 1433. This year a UNESCO grant to the IMU Commission on Development and Exchange, amounting to USD 5125, was added to the Fund. We also have a promise of an ICSU grant of USD 10 000 next year, to be used for travel grants.

In spite of the generous donations received, we are still far from our goal, USD 40 000. The Union appreciates every effort made towards reaching this goal.
